

Industry Visits

What are Industry Visits?

Industry visits involve groups of pupils from Derby schools in visiting local employers. The visits may take up to two hours during which time the employer will show pupils round the site as well as talk about the business and the career paths it offers. These visits are undertaken by pupils from both primary and secondary schools and serve to give young people a greater understanding of the world of work and the vast range of career options that could be open to them. The visit will include time for pupils to ask their own questions of the employer.

Typical school group sizes range between 10 and 35 pupils with the occasional group of 60. The size of group visiting is tailored to the capacity of the employer organisation.

What support will I get?

The E4E team is able to discuss what type of approach will be best received by young people and how to target the presentation to different ages of audience. The employer however will be responsible for the visit and presentation content.

How much time do I need to commit?

We consider this to be a half day commitment although the visit itself may only be up to two hours. Although we ask for a minimum commitment from volunteers of half a day a year, you are welcome to offer as many visits in a year as you are able.

How much time do I need to commit?

Visits may take between 2 - 4 hours and involve Businesses are welcome to carry out more than one visit per academic year should they wish to.
