### **What are Career Talks?**

This programme offers a range of options to suit the needs of the establishment and pupils - by way of speakers engaging audiences through their experiences and know-how and where appropriate using local labour market information, D2N2 (key sector) Escalators, STEMNET, etc. Schools gain access to our pool of 470 (and growing) E4E employer volunteers, representing over 130 businesses.

Careers talks: interventions will help build greater understanding of varying careers, career journeys, skill sets, barriers and challenges, and sharing inspirational moments and/or engage on the realities of the changing world-of-work.

### **What support will I get?**

The E4E team is able to discuss what type of approach will be best received by young people or how to target the presentation to different ages of audience. The volunteer however will be responsible for her/his own presentation content.

### **How much time do I need to commit?**

Talks are often range between 15-30 minutes, including time for questions from pupils. Volunteers are very welcome to undertake as many talks in a year as they are able.
